SoberRide Program Keeps Community/ Drivers Safe on July 4th Holiday Weekend



As it has done for the last ten years, Red Top Cab donated the support of five communications operators and two dispatchers on the 4th of July to handle the hundreds of calls that came into the Washington Regional Alcohol Program's (WRAP) SoberRide initiative. Red Top Cab contributes more than \$40,000 per year in volunteers and technical support as one of SoberRide's major local partners.

"With your company's key support, WRAP's 2009 July 4th SoberRide program provided 331 free cab rides home to would-be drunk drivers during last week's holiday," WRAP President & CEO Kurt Gregory Erickson told Red Top Vice President George Pakidis this week.

"Hailed as "one of the nation's most successful free taxi ride programs for would-be impaired drivers" (Washington Examiner, 7-3-09), the success of WRAP's 2009 Independence Day SoberRide campaign translated into the removal of a would-be drunk driver from our shared roadways every two minutes," Erickson said.

grade graduation in June was great. But that's not why he picked up a group of immigrant children four mornings a week for the past three years at their affordable apartment complex and brought them to school for early morning tutoring sessions with a reading specialist. Green says he knows exactly how important those sessions are for the children's future success.

"I was in the 9th grade when I first attended an integrated public school in Arlington in the early 60's," Green recalls. "I initially struggled in some of my classes, and an English teacher offered help before school in the mornings. I took advantage of that and benefited tremendously from

the experience. I know what a difference that extra support can mean in a student's life." Green went on to junior college and served in Viet Nam after high school, followed by a 20-year career with AT&T. He enjoys his current job because it allows him to meet and help people.

Science Focus School presented Green and Red Top Cab Vice President George Pakidis with their Gold Star Volunteer Award this year "for service above and beyond," Begley said. The company and Green were recipients of an Arlington Community Hero Award last year, and were recognized by the Arlington Retired Teachers Association in 2007 as well.
